

CORRECTIONS CALCUL

Il est indispensable de maîtriser les tables de multiplication pour réussir ces exercices

$$14 \times 5 = 5 \times 14 = 5 \times (10 + 4) = (5 \times 10) + (5 \times 4) = 50 + 20 = 70$$

$$123 \times 6 = 6 \times 123 = 6 \times (100 + 20 + 3) = (6 \times 100) + (6 \times 20) + (6 \times 3) = 600 + 120 + 18 = 738$$

$$27 \times 3 = 3 \times 27 = 3 \times (20 + 7) = (3 \times 20) + (3 \times 7) = 60 + 21 = 81$$

$$313 \times 4 = 4 \times 313 = 4 \times (300 + 10 + 3) = (4 \times 300) + (4 \times 10) + (4 \times 3) = 1\,200 + 40 + 12 = 1\,252$$

$$621 \times 5 = 5 \times 621 = 5 \times (600 + 20 + 1) = (5 \times 600) + (5 \times 20) + (5 \times 1) = 3\,000 + 100 + 5 = 3\,105$$
